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Investments

OXYMETAL EST has invested in a brand new measuring scanner.

This is a 2D optical scanner, format: 1250x1500, with repositioning possible for longer parts.


It has an accuracy of up to 14 microns per axis for the largest parts.

Advantages over its predecessor :

- up to 5 times more accurate
- better quality inspection reports
- improved ergonomics!



Safety report 2023



2023 was a good year from a safety point of view.

The two standard safety performance indicators are in the green: the results have improved compared with 2022 and are below the high thresholds set at the beginning of the year.

Some very good performances can also be noted:

- No accidents at Nantes in 2023, with a record of more than 420 days without a lost-time accident.
- New record for Verneuil: No lost-time accidents for 504 consecutive days. The previous record was 442 days.
- New record for the Group: No lost-time accidents for 99 consecutive days. The previous record was 59 days.

In 2024, we will continue our efforts in the various areas of safety: prevention, compliance with regulations and internal procedures, and analysis of incidents and accidents.

Growing Green competition

In July 2022 we launched the Growing Green competition within our Group so that all our employees could submit their ideas for improvements or innovative solutions to reduce our impact on the environment.

Here are the ideas that have been or are about to be implemented:

Welcome booklet including Growing Green gestures

In a few weeks' time, new arrivals will discover in their Welcome Pack a special «environment and ISO 14001» booklet in which they will be able to find good environmental practices.

Recyclable PPE

Rather than opt for recycling, we preferred to use non-disposable PPE (e.g. moulded ear plugs). Only gloves do not currently have a recycling network.

Impact of our e-mails

We mentioned the impact of e-mails on our carbon footprint. To mark Digital Cleanup Day, we launched a challenge to all our online employees to clean up their inboxes and files.

This operation enabled us to clean up 50 GB of emails and 1.6 GB of files. This will have saved us 250 kg of CO2 over the next few years! On the scale of what we generate, it seems derisory, but every gesture counts!

<u>Setting up a car-sharing platform</u> We're looking into the possibility of setting up a car-sharing platform. Before launching this platform, our employees

are invited to complete a survey to find out what they would be interested with.

Heroes'Race

On 9 June 2024, 38 employees from OXYMETAL SUD-OUEST, OXYMETAL OUEST and head office will set off on a walk or run in aid of the ALADIN33 association!

Thanks to the number of participants, OXYMETAL will already be able to donate €380 to the association.

The ALADIN association was set up by the nursing staff of the Children's Hospital at Bordeaux University Hospital with a twofold objective:

- To help improve the conditions in which they stay in hospital.
